### About the Role

The **Senior Associate**, **Research** will lead data-driven projects that provide the evidence base for policies designed to build collective Black wealth. This role requires a researcher who can apply interdisciplinary methodologies across economics, public policy, and sociology. The ideal candidate will have strong skills in quantitative and qualitative research, data analysis, and research translation for diverse audiences.

- Design and conduct research that advances Kindred's mission, addressing topics such as economic development, labor, taxation, housing, financial regulation, and shared ownership models
- Utilize quantitative and qualitative methodologies to assess economic trends, structural barriers, and policy impacts.
- Develop policy-focused research reports, briefs, and fact sheets that translate complex findings into clear, actionable insights.
- Apply data storytelling and visualization to make research accessible for policymakers, funders, and community partners.
- Utilize economic modeling, statistical analysis, and GIS mapping to identify trends and inform solutions.
- Collaborate with policy teams to ensure research directly informs legislative action and systemic change.

- Support research efforts related to financial protections, tax policy reform, anti-displacement policies, and reparative wealth strategies.
- Supervise and mentor the Research Assistant, ensuring high-quality research execution, data management, and analysis support.
